<u>State Achievement Awards</u> - Deadline to apply January 26

4-H Achievement Awards are based on a 4-H member's achievement in a specific area and open to all ages. The award includes a trip to the National 4-H Congress held in Atlanta, GA. Areas include: Beef, CARTEENS, Citizenship & Community Service, Clothing & Textiles, Communications, Companion Animals, Creative Arts, Dairy, Environmental Sciences, Family Life & Child Development, Foods & Nutrition, Gardening & Horticulture, Goat, Health & Safety, Horse, Leadership, Llamas, Mechanical & Engineering Sciences, Personal Development, Photography, Poultry, Rabbits, Sheep, Shooting Sports, Swine, Woodworking and Veterinary Science. To be considered for a 4-H Achievement Award, one must complete an Ohio 4-H Achievement Record form and submit it to the Extension Office.
