Our goal is to have 800+ items donated.

How does my club get involved?

1. Email Jenny at the Extension Office and let her know that your club is going to participate by May 1. Your club may begin working on this project asap!
2. 4-H Clubs will decide on a small "homemade gift" that fits inside of a brown lunch bag. Examples include paper flowers or hearts, paperclip angels, collage bookmarks or magnets, small, decorated note cards with greetings...the sky is the limit! Craft items can be simple and budget friendly, the simple gesture of making something special is very valuable!
3. Schedule time during your meetings to work on your homemade gifts. We are asking clubs to make approximately 20-25 small homemade gifts to share. Brown lunch bags will be provided by the Extension Office and members can decorate them also with 4-H greetings and the name of your 4-H club!
4. Submit photos of members working on the "4-H Senior Smiles" project to morlock.3@osu.edu
5. Deliver your gifts to the Extension Office by July 15.
