Project Description

This project is for members who want to make a photography project in a category that is different from other 4-H photography project categories or that requires specialized or professional-level skills beyond those typically used in other 4-H photography projects. Members of any age may complete this project but should have previous photography experience (comparable to what is required for other advanced-level 4-H photography projects) and be able to plan and complete the project on their own with minimal supervision or assistance.

To Complete the Project

1. Plan, execute and evaluate at least 1 photography project. What you do should be difference from what you can do within the guidelines of other 4-H photography project categories or required specialized or professional level skills to complete it (beyond what would be expected in other photography projects).
2. Take part in at least 2 learning experiences.
3. Take part in at least 2 leadership/citizenship activities.
4. Explore career opportunities in which you might apply or use what you learn by completing this Project.
5. Keep records of what you do, when you do it, how much you spend, and what you learn as you complete the project.
6. Create a portfolio that features your work in their project, including images that show what you are learning.
7. Take part in 4-H project judging. If you choose not to participate in judging, plan to discuss and review completion of your project with your 4-H Advisor.

Judging of this Project

Interview judging for this project will be on Non-Livestock judging day at the Jr. Fair building. Please refer to the 4-H calendar for judging dates.

*Requirements for Judging:

1. Completed project book.
2. Portfolio to share with the judge.

Project Display

Prepare a display that shows the judge and fair visitors what you learned and accomplished in your project. For example, something you made, visuals or other items used to complete project activities, or a poster to share learned information.

Your project book cannot serve as your project display.

Display Areas

At the Wood County Fair, your 4-H project will be displayed in the Wood County Jr. Fair building in your 4-H Club assigned booth.

Project Pick-Up

You must pick up your project display at the end of the fair or arrange for someone to get it for you. Please refer to the Wood County Fair book or the 4-H Newsletter for project release times.

Projects not picked up by 3:00 p.m. on the last day of the fair will be disposed of.
